DIPLOMAS

EXAMPLE OF A TYPICAL 90-CREDIT, 3-YEAR BACHELOR'S PROGRAM

UNDERGRADUATE DIPLOMAS

Bachelor's Degree (90 credits or more)

Specialized Bachelor's Degree and Undergraduate Doctorate: The majority of credits are obtained within the same discipline. This program may lead to graduate studies.

Multidisciplinary Bachelor's Degree: Credits are divided between different fields of study.

Bidisciplinary Bachelor's Degree: Students obtain an equal number of credits from two related areas of study. This program may lead to graduate studies in one of the two disciplines.

Combined Bachelor's Degree: A major is combined with a minor, or a major is combined with a certificate. This degree may lead to graduate studies in the discipline of the major. The combined bachelor's degree may also consist of three minors (or certificates) or even two majors.

Duration: 3 years or more

Major (60 credits)

A major is the main component of a multidisciplinary bachelor's degree. It may constitute a diploma in itself.

Duration: 2 years

Minor or Certificate (30 credits)

This program may be combined with two other minors or certificates or with a major to create a bachelor's degree.

Duration: 1 year or more

Microprogram

8 to 18 credits
May be a first step toward a specialized graduate diploma (DESS) or a master's degree.

DIPLOMAS

GRADUATE DIPLOMAS

Microprogram (8 to 18 credits)

Introduction to a specialization

For students enrolled in a university program or professionals

Duration: 1 to 3 years

As enrolment is generally part-time, this type of program is usually not suitable for international students.

DESS (30 credits)

(Specialized Graduate Diploma)

Acquire the fundamentals of a specialization and apply a set of targeted skills.

Duration: 2 to 3 sessions

Master's Degree (45 credits)

Research Master's (with thesis)

Develop a deeper understanding in an area of specialization and gain an introduction to research. For those who intend to pursue doctoral studies or who want to acquire basic research training.

Professional or Specialized Master's (without thesis)

Develop the skills required for a specific profession. Coursework and internship or directed study.

Duration: 1 to 2 years

DIPLOMA AT THE DOCTORAL LEVEL

Doctorate/PhD (90 credits)

Training of researchers and research professors.

Original scientific research based on a proven methodology. Coursework and comprehensive exam. Thesis and defence.

Duration: 4 to 5 years

POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

Acquire expertise in a specialized field of research or one that is complementary to your training. Full-time research under a professor's supervision. Communication of research results to the scientific community.

Duration: 6 months to 3 years
